

# How to paint metal

Have a metal surface to paint? Follow these steps to get the best results.

First off, get rid of any traces of rust. To do this you can use a steel brush, an emery board or a file. If unsightly welds are revealed in the process, sand them down until the metal is smooth. Certain household chemicals and products, such as phosphorus and oven cleaners, are also useful for getting rid of rust.

Next, clean the metal using a damp sponge, and then dry the surface with a clean cloth. As soon as you're done cleaning — don't wait too long, as bare metal is quick to rust — apply a coat of primer designed for metal and compatible with the paint you'll be using. Once the base coat is dry (refer to the manufacturer's instructions for drying time), apply as many coats of paint as necessary. You can use a regular paintbrush, but spraying the paint on (either with a spray gun or a can of spray paint) will prevent visible brush strokes

There you have it: all that's left is to admire the result.

Glossy paint dries more slowly than other finishes and makes fingerprints quite noticeable.

important to note that most non-greasy stains easily disappear when lightly dabbed at with a moist cloth. Act quickly and make sure to use a light-coloured fabric to clean with — certain colours bleed, which would only make things worse.

Still seeing the stain? Trade in your cloth for a cotton ball dipped in makeup remover and lightly dab that pesky spot. If you're trying to get rid of an alcohol or a soot stain, add a few drops of vinegar to your cotton ball. As for coffee, tea, dye

and ink, a drop of rubbing alcohol should do the trick

Leather reacts poorly to moisture. For this reason, don't let it get too wet during the stain removal process, and make sure to dry the surface thoroughly with a you've dealt with the stain. It's also important to avoid scrubbing at all costs, opting instead for a delicate dabbing technique. Lastly, always spot test stain removal products on a non-visible area before using them to avoid accidental damage.

### Build your own backyard bar this summer

Do you basically live on your patio during the summer? Then why not set up a bar area to have everything you need to prepare refreshing cocktails — and tasty snacks — close at hand? Tempted? Here are some things to consider.

First off, determine how you'll be using your bar. For instance, would you like to be able to enjoy it on rainy days or late in the season? ### ORNAMENTAL GRASS Eye-catching and easy to grow

Ornamental grass is increasingly popular among homeowners looking to embellish their outdoor space. Graceful and light, these plants — characterized by thin, long foliage — complement every style of landscape. Ornamental grasses traditionally border water gardens and Zen corners; however, more and more gardeners are making the bold move of planting them in the heart of their flowerbeds mixed with various annuals and perennials.

Resistant to drought, illness and destructive insects, ornamental grass is extremely easy to maintain. The majority of varieties only require a 10-centimetre trim every spring, while evergreen varieties like blue oat grass don't require any trimming at all. Furthermore, ornamental grass grows vigorously in poor (anemic) soil, as long as it's well drained. Add a bit of fertilizer upon planting and you're set!

Are you afraid that ornamental grass will take over your garden? Visit your local garden centre or plant nursery to find varieties that remain compact as they grow, such as silver grass (*Miscanthus*), red grass (*Calamagrostis*) and greater wood-rush (Luzula sylvatica), the latter of which is perfect for shaded areas.

Boasting feathery spikes and green, red, yellow or blue foliage, ornamental grass is sure to embellish your property and attract the eye of passers-by all season long!



# When is the best time to water your plants?

Do you usually water your plants in the middle of the day when the sun is at its zenith? If so, you should rethink that habit! Midday is actually the worst time to accomplish this task. Ecologically speaking, you risk wasting more water due to the strong sunlight prompting rapid evaporation.

The solution? Take out the hose either in the early hours of the morning or when the sun starts to set. At daybreak the sun is still cool, which means water won't evaporate as swiftly. Furthermore, it's actually healthy for a plant's foliage to dry out gradually throughout the day. A drier foliage protects your flowers and shrubs from disease related to high levels of humidity.

Consequently, when watering at dusk, aim for the ground rather than the foliage. If not, humidity will cling to your plants throughout the long hours of the night, which can cause spores or other harmful bacteria to grow.
