

How to choose the right fertilizer for your lawn



Every lawn requires its own unique blend of nutrients to thrive. This fact is reflected by the many varieties of fertilizer on the market. If you want healthy grass, it's important that you choose the type of fertilizer best suited to your particular lawn.

Understanding fertilizer labels

The key information on a unit of fertilizer is contained in a chain of three numbers separated by dashes. These numbers, often referred to as an NPK ratio, typically

ten referred to as an NPK ratio, typically appear on the front packaging.

Fertilizer numbers indicate the percentage of nitrogen, phosphorus and potassium the fertilizer contains — in that order! These are the main nutrients your lawn needs and they perform different functions.

functions.

Nitrogen promotes plant growth and makes your grass greener; phosphorus promotes root growth and potassium builds strong cells within the plant tissue. Selecting your fertilizer

The fertilizer you add to your lawn should supplement what's lacking in the soil. For instance, if your soil lacks nitrogen, has ample phosphorus and almost enough potassium, you might choose a fertilizer marked 34-0-4.

To find out what nutrients your lawn needs, pick up an inexpensive soil test kit

needs, pick up an inexpensive soil test kit at a garden centre. If you want a more de-tailed evaluation, get a lawn care profes-sional to perform one.

Three tips to prevent water damage this spring

Jeannot anticipates increased interest in solar

Moosomin electrician Kyle Jeannot took the training to start installing solar panels last May, and says he feels solar

panels last May, and says he reels solar is a growth industry in Southeast Saskatchewan, especially since the carbon tax came into effect.

"It is a whole new market to get into," he says. "It's a good fit for our company, and with the carbon tax coming in, everyledy wreathed wreather. erybody wants to be more energy effi-

There has been a lot of interest in solar. We had three systems booked within our first year and we've got another three booked already for 2019. More people are getting interested in it."

Jeannot says he's seen interest from a range of different people who own a

range of different kinds of properties.
"We've had interest from everybody

from farmers to people in town,"

"We've had two who live in Moosomin, two will be done here at the end of April, and then we had one up at Langenburg too, it was on a farm."

He says once the carbon tax came into

effect, he had a number of calls that day



asking about solar.

"I've had a lot more interest since the carbon tax came in. A lot of people have

been calling and just quizzing me up on it, asking a few questions on how it's going to save them money. Their power

bills are going up, so they want to cut costs where they can.
"I think it's going to drive it more.
And then with SaskPower having the 20 per cent rebate on still, it definitely belos out." helps out.

Jeannot says he can see solar making up a larger part of his business some

day.
"I think it's a little early but I'm hoping it could make up 25 per cent of my business. Ideally I'd like to have a solar crew and an electrical crew one day, but you never know where it's going to end up at," he says.

As for other people installing solar in rural Southeast Saskatchewan, he said he's heard of some companies coming out of the cities, but there appear to be few people living in the rural areas who do it. He says he's the only person he knows of in the Moosomin area who is installing solar power systems right

'We've run into a lot of the guys out of the city coming and putting in solar, but that's about it so far. I am the only one I know of around here doing it," he
